## **Grade 9 Leadership**

The CMJHS Grade 9 Leadership classes focus on supporting the local and global community by devoting time and energy to a variety of projects and volunteer opportunities throughout the school year. This is an integral part of developing citizenship in our students

In December we concentrate on encouraging our fellow school mates to give to others less fortunate.

Our food collection drive kicks off with the “Hockey for Hunger” event at the beginning of December, where students cheer on the members of our school hockey program and bring non perishable goods for the local Christmas Hamper program. This continues until December 15 this year as a POD vs POD competition, using grocery carts at school as a measurement device!

Our Leadership classes are also responsible for bringing items for three days of bake sales to raise funds for the purchase of goats and chickens to encourage sustainability for farmers in African countries. All contributions are welcome- goodies and funds.

As volunteers at the local Crisis Shelter, our students discovered that many pre-teens and teens housed there do not receive Christmas gifts, as the majority of donations include toys and stuffed animals. This has led to the creation of “Warm Fuzzy Day”, where homerooms compete against each other by donating gift cards for various store locations, or socks and pyjamas. Students are encouraged to wear their jammies that day- the winner receives donuts from Rocky’s bakery.

Finally, students who attended WE Day are selling Rafiki bracelets to raise funds for education and clean water in Kenya and Ethiopia.
